New for this year – People's Choice Voting
Fair spectators will have the opportunity to vote for the "Best in Show" item (One item in each category will be selected by the fair and it will be displayed for the People's Choice Voting)

ALL items must be properly equipped for displaying or hung and must be entered in the name of the person who crafted/created the item.

There will be no limit on the number of items entered per person (within reason) for each category & sub-category.

Quality is important. Even if an item is the only one in its category – it may not receive a prize. Be sure to snip loose threads, was the glass in frames, press cloth items and the items to be hung have proper wire and hooks. Any items not clean or properly prepared will be disqualified.

No profanity of any kind may be displayed on any artwork/crafts.

All artwork and photographs must be framed and/or matted, with eyelets/hooks and wire on the back. Please do not use tape or fishing line as they will not be strong enough for hanging.

All Art & Craft items that are entered must have been created within the last Blue Hill Fair *calendar* year.

Adult & Youth items will be judged separately. Youth artwork needs to be matted or mounted on heavy cardboard.
